

**VILLAGE OF SOUTH LEBANON
MINUTES
WORKSHOP MEETING
APRIL 1, 2010
6:30 P.M.**

1. Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

3. Mayor Smith opened the floor to Bruce McGary – Chief Asst. Prosecutor Warren County - Bruce reviewed the reports of 2009. Said the prosecutor’s office has 97 employees, 25 of which are prosecutors.

He reviewed some of the entities they represent, such as board of Elections and Lebanon Library. Mayor Smith asked how libraries are broken up and Bruce said probably by school districts. All other information reviewed is on record in the form of his reports.

4. Mayor Smith stated he and Bob attended the presentation of the \$50,000 check presented to the early learning center by Fifth Third Bank.

5. Mayor Smith said there will be a donation request before council at the regular meeting from the Humane Assoc.

6. Administrator Craig introduced Mary Ellen Bonner – she stated she would like to use the ball fields for softball tournaments. The tournament would be a fund raiser for the program. She said it is a chance for junior high to play in a tournament fashion. Mary Ellen said they used to use the high school but that field is not being maintained. They would need two fields and would be supervised. The date is May 1st and 2nd. She said they would need the rest rooms and they would have a tent and table for concessions. There were no objections from council. Council member Holloway stated they should not park in the church parking lot.

7. Bob said Rivers Edge was bonded under the county and they held the bond even after they annexed. He said he and the HOA representative met and they are looking at pursuing a developer/bank lien on a lot. Roads need repair and may have to split between the home owners.

Bob said he is getting estimates on paving the ball field parking lots.

Bob said that Kohl's has a community service plan and would like to plant where the sign was moved in front of the old school. There were no objections from council.

Bob said the spring clean up will be May 1st from 8:00 a.m. to noon.

8. Mayor Smith said we need to have signs to mark the park locations and canoe access. Bob will get prices.
9. Mayor Smith stated we are putting a space on the village web site for Veterans. We would like a picture and bio from anyone past or present who served. Carbo asked about pictures and Bob said he does not think we are limited with our server. Mayor Smith said we will do a press release and put it on the utility bills.
10. Council member Atkins asked if Bob has a company vehicle and Bob stated he has a travel expense for using his own vehicle.
11. A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:20 p.m. by Madison, seconded by Holloway, all yeas.
