1. Mayor Lawhorn called the meeting to order at 6:50 p.m.

3. Mayor Lawhorn stated that Linda had a death in Florida.
4. Vidmar stated he updated his report and highlighted the Corwin Nixon Extension. He said they have been negotiating with ODOT and the sticking points have been future improvements that have been promised to them, specifically the widening of the ramp coming off N. Bound 71 on to 48 and lengthening of the turning lane from N. Bound 48 left to S. Bound 71 and now an issue with the Speedway drive, where they want a limited right turn in and right turn out. We have agreeable terms with ODOT for the Speedway drive. Gary said these will be tagged to the permit as a condition of the permit they release. Smith asked who they are dealing with and Gary said Jay Hamilton and a woman that had Jay's job prior to him, Chris Hilbert that now works for CESO, who is Speedway's engineer. Discussed issues and meeting ODOT's conditions. Gary said Speedway had to close on their financing and the drive is also a hold up. Atkins asked if they are not going to start until March and Gary said the Corwin Nixon Extension will start in January and then Speedway is anticipating starting in March. Boerio asked with the anticipation of increase in traffic and this turning lane from 48 to 71, and if there is any thought to illumination of where 48 and 71 come together. Gary said he could find out. Smith stated there is an issue with traffic backing up at 71 and 48 and issues and solutions to the problem.
5. Mayor Lawhorn asked that the Park Committee meet about the water feature before budget.
6. Mayor Lawhorn said the Warren County Municipal League just sent the meeting notice out and he needs to know who will attend.

7. Mayor Lawhorn said the first meeting in January will be January 8th instead of the 1st of January.
8. A motion to adjourn the meeting was made at 7:02 p.m. by Boerio, seconded by Atkins, all yeas.
