RESOLUTION NO. 2015-36

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2015 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS THE
OFFICIAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH
LEBANON

WHEREAS, the Village of South Lebanon, Warren County, Ohio is most vulnerable to natural hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Village of South Lebanon acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Warren County Emergency Management Agency in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the Village of South Lebanon; and,

WHEREAS, a FEMA-required public participation process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, , the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of South Lebanon, Ohio, at least a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Village of South Lebanon; and,

Section 2. That the respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.

Section 3. That the Council is acting in its administrative capacity in adopting this Resolution.

Section 4. That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


