



**VILLAGE OF SOUTH LEBANON
MINUTES
WORKSHOP MEETING
JULY 7, 2016
7:50 P.M.**

1. Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:50 p.m. with the Pledge.
2. Randall Atkins - Absent Steve Riley - Present
James Boerio- Present Bill Madison – Present
Sue Johnson – Present George Teasdale - Absent
3. Mayor Smith said the Ilene project is going well. He said with the rain infiltration is happening in the sewer. He said the sooner we get the project completed the better. He said once this project is finished we will fan in the next project and those homes are going in fast. Jerry said he will send in the EPA application tomorrow and get the bids out. He said the estimate is \$73,000 for the project and hopefully it comes in at that or a little less. Mayor Smith said included in the bid is to fill in the old pipe and once that is done we can abandon that pipe.
4. Mayor Smith said they are waiting on low water to get started on the boat ramp. He said we went to the fire department to make sure the safety hooks are incorporated into it for the rescue purpose. He said it will be the only access between Morrow and Kings Mills. He said Jerry made a suggestion for an observation tower on the corner, which we could do in house.
5. Haddix said the section on Cochran in front of Wynstead for paving is part of the county project. He said that will start later in the month. Boerio asked if they are going to widen it and was told it is just an overlay.
6. Madison stated that the Chic Fil A lot looks like it is grown up and needs attention. Mayor Smith said they were called yesterday and if the developer or Chic Fil A don't get it taken care of we would do it and bill them for it. Madison said coming off Lebanon Road on to Corwin Nixon there are shrubs that are dead and need to be removed or replaced. Jerry said he spoke with Midland about working on the lights as well.
7. A motion to adjourn the meeting was made at 7:59 p.m. by Boerio, seconded by Riley, all yeas.
