1. Mayor Smith opened the meeting at 6:31 p.m. with the Pledge.
2. A motion to appoint Bob Craig to take minutes of meeting in Sharon's absence was made by Carbo, seconded by Holloway, all yeas.
3. Solicitor Nixon stated that it is his opinion that the village can pass legislation more restrictive than the State law for sex offenders. He stated that there is no case law at this time. He said the City of Upper Arlington requires that offenders register with the local court with non-registration being a misdemeanor. This registration establishes residence and work restrictions. Keith said a Supreme Court case does not allow anything to be retro-active. After discussion it was decided that Keith will draft an ordinance with aid from the Upper Arlington attorney and the county prosecutor's opinion. Maryann Harrison – citizen – questions the Early Learning Center and their lack of State certification and notes that multiple convicted felons are living in the same household. Mayor Smith suggests that the solicitor be authorized to interpret statute and draft legislation for the December workshop. Council members suggested a 2,500 feet restriction be required, local registration with clerk of courts, maximum penalty a misdemeanor and restrictions be schools, parks, ball fields, designated bus stops, and places children congregate without parental supervision. Bob will check with Head Start as to their certification. A motion to allow Keith to draft an ordinance restricting sex offenders was made by Holloway, seconded by Madison, all yeas.
4. Mayor Smith presented the following minutes for approval:

5. Ordinance 2009-14 was presented which allows the mayor to notify Time Warner Cable of the franchise fee should they get the contract. A motion to waive the reading rule was made by Holloway, seconded by Evans, all yeas. A motion to adopt Ordinance 2009-14 was made by Holloway, seconded by Evans, all yeas.
6. Ordinance 2009-13 was presented accepting the Froehlich annexation. A motion to waive the reading rule was made by Madison, seconded by Sturtevant, all yeas. A motion to adopt Ordinance 2009-13 was made by Holloway, seconded by Evans, all yeas.
7. Solicitor Nixon's invoice was presented for payment in the amount of \$1770.00. A motion to allow payment was made by Holloway, seconded by Carbo, all yeas.
8. The Ohio Municipal League Dues for 2010 were presented in the amount of \$676. A motion to pay the dues was made by Holloway, seconded by Madison, all yeas.
9. Administrator Craig said he will bring park plans to next meeting. Mayor Smith said we can ask for donation and with a donation of at least \$1000 their name could be on a plaque.
10. A motion to go into executive session to discuss personnel at 6:55 p.m. by Holloway, seconded by Carbo, all yeas.

11. A motion was made by Holloway to terminate the Laborer II probationary periods for Coomer and Wilson and to give them the fifty cent raises immediately, seconded by Evans, all yeas.
