Subject: Change Order Pauline Drive Stormwater Project

The installation of the Pauline Drive Stormwater Project has caused extensive damage to sections of Mary Lane, Claude, and Pauline Drive. Staff is recommending the entire roadway in these sections be repaved. The original contract price for this project was \$387,202.40. Siteworx is under budget on this project by \$37,348.50. The cost of paving this area is \$65,310.00. This will cause an increase to the original contract of \$27,961.50 for a new grand total of \$415,163.90.

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-53 and entered a contract with SiteWorx, LLC ("Contractor") for the construction of the Pauline Drive Stormwater Drainage Project in the amount of \$387,202.40; and,

WHEREAS, various bid items were non-performed due to not being completed as noted the attached change order resulting in a deduction of \$37,348.50 from the contract price; and,

WHEREAS, due to the extensive damage to the existing pavement during construction, asphalt resurfacing along the length of the entire Project is necessary to maintain the integrity of the existing pavement for an increase of \$65,310.00 to the contract, which, with the above deductions, results is a net increase in the original contract cost of \$27,961.50 and a total contract price of \$415,163.90; and,

WHEREAS, immediate action is required to approve said change order to expedite the repair of the damaged pavement and such action is necessary in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City.

Subject: Employee Benefits - Insurance Renewal Plans

Attached is a resolution to renew employee insurance benefit plans for health, dental, vision and life insurance. The city currently pays 89% of the premium for medical and dental benefits and the employee pays the additional 11%. The city covers 100% of vision and life insurance premiums.

Our employee health insurance renewal date is May 1, 2023. Our current medical insurance carrier, Anthem, renewal rate is an 8.87% increase in premiums with **no changes** to our current plan coverage.

Our insurance broker Derek Carnohan from National Employer Solutions Team, LLC, has also presented the City with alternative plans from other insurance providers. All other providers considered presented a much larger increase in premium costs for coverage similar to our current plan.

Therefore, staff is recommending Council accept the current plan renewal of 8.87% with Anthem. Attached is a benefit comparison sheet for all plans that were considered.

Based on current employees enrolled in the plan, an 8.87% renewal rate will increase the employer share of medical premiums \$14,460/year from \$168,346 to \$182,806.

Superior Dental is our current carrier for dental insurance. There was no increase in rates or changes to coverage. The city currently pays \$8,326/ year in premiums for dental care.

Vision Service Plan (VSP) is our current carrier for vision insurance. There was also no change in rates for the renewal period. The city currently pays \$3,200/year in premiums for vision care.

Our current life insurance plan is with Humana. Employees life insurance coverage is equal to 1 x their salary amount. There was no change in our renewal rate, \$.59 cents per thousand. The city pays approximately \$5,620/year in premiums for life insurance.

The total employer paid benefits is approximately \$199,952/ plan year.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF THE CITY'S [TRADITIONAL] HEALTH INSURANCE, DENTAL, VISION AND LIFE INSURANCE PLANS WHICH ARE OFFERED TO FULL-TIME CITY EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City currently offers health insurance coverage for full-time employees as an employee benefit consisting of a low-deductible [traditional] health insurance plan from Anthem; and,

WHEREAS, the City staff has obtained quotes for health, dental, vision and life insurance; and,

WHEREAS, the most cost effective quote obtained for health insurance is the low deductible [traditional] plan from Anthem with a \$1,500 annual deductible for an individual plan, and \$3,000 annual deductible for a family plan, which provides 80% coverage of medical charges after the deductible limits are met, with a 20% co-pay required as stipulated in the plan and with a 8.87% increase in total premium costs from the current plan; and,

WHEREAS, the most cost effective quote obtained for dental insurance is the present POS plan from Superior Dental; and,

WHEREAS, the most cost effective quote obtained for vision insurance is the present plan from Vision Service Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the most cost effective quote obtained for life insurance is the current life insurance plan from Humana; and,

WHEREAS, the City shall continue to pay 89% of the premium cost for each employee covered by the health and dental plans; and,

WHEREAS, the City shall continue to pay 100% of the premium cost for each employee covered by the vision and life insurance plans; and,

WHEREAS, the City shall offer employees eleven percent (11%) of any premium cost savings the City receives as a result of the employee's participation in the Anthem SOCA Benefit Plan Blue Access; and

WHEREAS, immediate action is required to assure continued insurance coverage for full-time employees offered health, dental, vision and life insurance in accordance with the terms of their employment benefits and is the most cost effective means for doing so, and such action is necessary in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of South Lebanon, Ohio, at least two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Council approves and authorizes the health insurance contract with Anthem from May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2024.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Council approves and authorizes the renewal of the dental insurance contract with Superior Dental Care from April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024.

As part of our Memorial Park Playground Project, we will be replacing the existing curb on the west side of High Street between Forest Avenue and Broadway Street with a 6" tall curb. We will also remove the existing gravel parking in this area and installing a small mound for grass and decorative trees. The street in this area is not wide enough to allow on street on both sides of the street so we need to install the no parking signs in this area. This will add an additional safety measure to our playground.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-09

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NO PARKING REGULATION AND AUTHORIZING NO PARKING SIGNAGE ON THE WEST SIDE OF HIGH STREET BETWEEN FOREST AND BROADWAY STREETS

WHEREAS, Ohio Rev. Code § 4511.07(A)(1) permits local municipalities to create laws "[r]egulating the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles, trackless trolleys, and streetcars"; and,

WHEREAS, the City previously established parking violations upon the adoption of the Ohio Basic Code in Ordinance No. 2023-04, specifically Ohio Basic Code § 76.04. Said Ordinance enforces parking violations as criminal offenses; and,

WHEREAS, due to the removal of off-street parking and the installation of a new curb on the west side of High Street at the new playground, the roadway is not wide enough for parking on both sides of the street, so no parking signs need to be installed on the west side of High Street between Forest Avenue and Broadway Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of South Lebanon, at a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council does hereby establish a no parking regulation on the west side of High Street between Forest Avenue and Broadway Streets as delineated on the attached map:

<u>Section 2</u>. That the City Council authorizes City employees to install no parking signage on the west side of High Street between Forest Avenue and Broadway Street, and that said regulation shall be enforced pursuant to Ordinance 2023-04 and Ohio Basic Code § 76.04.

Section 3. The owner of a vehicle shall be entitled to establish nonliability for prosecution for violation of this Ordinance by proving the vehicle was in the care, custody, or control of a person other than the owner at the time of the violation pursuant to a written rental or lease agreement or affidavit providing that except for such agreement, no other business relationship with respect to the vehicle in question exists between the operator and owner. Proof that the vehicle was in the care, custody, or control of a person other than the owner shall be established by sending a copy of such written rental or lease agreement or affidavit to the

prosecuting authority within thirty days from the date of receipt by the owner of the notice of violation. The furnishing of a copy of a written rental or lease agreement or affidavit shall be prima-facie evidence that a vehicle was in the care, custody, or control of a person other than the owner.

<u>Section 5.</u> That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

<u>Section 6</u>. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to passing this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.




