## CITY OF SOUTH LEBANON, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2021-46

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2000-04 AND FIXING THE RESIDENTIAL TAP-IN FEES FOR THE SOUTH LEBANON WATER SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the then-Village Council adopted Ordinance No. 2000-04 fixing the water tap-in fees for residential users in the Village at \$2,400 per residence; and,

WHEREAS, per Resolution No. 2021-10 and the accompanying Agreement with the Warren County Board of Commissioners sets the amount to be paid to the County for each new single family residential water connection at \$4,000 per dwelling; and,

**WHEREAS**, due to the increasing costs of capital improvements and the necessity for future water system improvements, it is necessary to increase the tap-in fee for new residential water connections in the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the amount paid to the County per said Agreement, the City requires an amount for future capital improvements for water service in this area; and,

**WHEREAS**, immediate action is required to assure that the water tap-in fees are in effect immediately, in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of South Lebanon, Ohio, at least two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Ordinance No. 2000-04 is hereby amended to the extent that the following residential water tap-in fees shall be effective on the following dates:

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code § 731.30 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare; and, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.

<u>Section 5.</u> That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
