CITY OF SOUTH LEBANON, OHIO ORDINANCE 2022-20

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR THE ONE OHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO DEPOSIT FUNDS INTO SUCH ACCOUNT AND PAY QUALIFIED EXPENDITURES FROM SAID FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The State of Ohio has reached a \$808 million agreement with the three largest distributors of opioids; and

WHEREAS, the settlement allocates 30% to local governments; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 5705.09(F) requires subdivisions to establish separate funds for each class of revenue derived from a source other than the general property tax; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 5705.10(I) states that money paid into a fund must be used only for the purposes for which such fund is established; and

WHEREAS, immediate action is required to establish the fund in order to properly receipt settlement funds, and such action is necessary in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of South Lebanon, at least a two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the City Council does hereby create a fund to be known as the OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund. Expenditures made from this fund shall comply with the allowable uses contained within the OneOhio memorandum of understanding (MOU).

<u>Section 2</u>. That the Council authorizes the Fiscal Officer to establish said fund and to deposit monies therein as indicated by Council.

<u>Section 3</u>. That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code § 731.30 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health safety and general welfare; and, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.

<u>Section 5.</u> That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to passing this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
