WHEREAS, Catherine A. Cunningham and the law firm of Kegler, Brown, Hill & Ritter, LPA have provided a proposed engagement letter dated May 17, 2022, for consideration; and,

WHEREAS, immediate action is required to assure prompt outside counsel legal services, and such action is necessary in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of South Lebanon, Ohio, at least two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1</u>. That the Council authorizes the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to enter into the Engagement Letter, dated May 17, 2022, with Catherine A. Cunningham and the law firm of Kegler, Brown, Hill & Ritter, LPA.
- <u>Section 2</u>. That outside counsel legal services of Catherine A. Cunningham and the law firm of Kegler, Brown, Hill & Ritter, LPA will be utilized and authorized on an as-needed basis.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.
