## A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE WARREN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE WARREN COUNTY ENGINEER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Warren County Engineer has submitted a pre-application to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for the Pike Street Bridge Replacement Project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of South Lebanon has elected to participate in this Project with Warren County and has budgeted \$25,000 to the construction of this Project; and,

WHEREAS, OPWC regulations require the execution of a cooperation agreement with all involved entities to be considered a multi-jurisdictional project and to score additional project scoring points for being a multi-jurisdictional project; and,

**WHEREAS**, immediate action is required in order to allow Warren County Engineer's Office to move forward with this project and such action is necessary in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of South Lebanon, at least two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1</u>. Approve and authorize the Mayor and City Administrator to execute a Cooperation Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto, with the Warren County Board of County Commissioners and the Warren County Engineer.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

<u>Section 3</u>. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
