ORDINANCE NO. 2016-09

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH LEBANON TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act. (AM. Sub. H.B. No. 100), as signed into law on December 4, 1985

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provides the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities or port authorities and school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts and park districts and other authorities, to participate in contracts distributed by the state of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials ; and

WHEREAS, immediate action is required in order to complete the enrollment process with the State of Ohio prior to purchasing through this program and such action is necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the Village

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of South Lebanon, Ohio, at least two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Officer hereby requests authority in the name of the Village of South Lebanon to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into and the Office of Cooperative Purchasing has distributed for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain other materials pursuant to Revised Code Section 125.04.

Section 2. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of South Lebanon to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of the Village of South Lebanon participation in the contract. Further, that the Fiscal Officer does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to

non-members of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by ORC 125.04

Section 3. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of South Lebanon to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Fiscal Officer does hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.

Section 4. That the Council is acting in its legislative capacity in approving this Ordinance.

Section 5. That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code § 731.30 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare; and, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.

Section 7. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of Council in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
