A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE A FISCAL YEAR 2016 (FY2016) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PROCESS THE APPLICATION WITHOUT DELAY TO THE WARREN COUNTY OFFICE OF GRANTS ADMINISTRATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Village Administrator shall process the executed Application to the Warren County Office of Grants Administration without further delay.

<u>Section 4</u>. That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code § 731.30 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare; and, this Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.
