## VILLAGE OF SOUTH LEBANON, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2019-8

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2019-6 RELATING TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN DOGWOOD TRAILS SUBDIVISION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2019, the Village Council passed Ordinance 2019-06; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Ordinance 2019-06 states:

**Section 1.** The Village Council does hereby establish a no parking regulation . . . both sides of all public streets in the Dogwood Trails Subdivision.

WHEREAS, at the May 1, 2019 Regular Meeting, Village Council expressed a desire to revoke the no parking regulation in the Dogwood Trails Subdivision to further investigate citizen concerns; and,

WHEREAS, immediate action is required to amend Ordinance 2019-06, as the no parking regulations go into effect on May 18, 2019, and in order to preserve the public peace, health, or safety of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of South Lebanon, at least a two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Ordinance 2019-06 is hereby amended as follows:

"WHEREAS, the width of the streets within the Dogwood Trails Subdivision are twenty (20) feet or less;

WHEREAS, on street parking in the Dogwood Trails Subdivision creates a disruption to public and emergency services along these streets;

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it necessary to prohibit the public on-street parking on one side of the street in the Stone Lake Subdivision and both sides of the streets in the Dogwood Trails Subdivision to preserve the public safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of South Lebanon.

<u>Section 1</u>. The Village Council does hereby establish a no parking regulation on one side of all public streets in the Stone Lake Subdivision and both sides of all public streets in the Dogwood Trails Subdivision.

<u>Section 2</u>. That the Village Council authorizes Village employees to install no parking signage on one side of public streets in the Stone Lake Subdivision and both sides of public streets in the Dogwood Trails Subdivision, and that said regulation shall be enforced pursuant to Ordinance 2019-03 and Ohio Basic Code § 76.04."

<u>Section 2.</u> That the recitals contained within the Whereas Clauses set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

<u>Section 3</u>. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4</u>. That this Ordinance is declared to be emergency legislation, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, which shall be effective upon passage
