## VILLAGE OF SOUTH LEBANON, OHIO ORDINANCE 2020-10

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH LEBANON, STATE OF OHIO, FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2020 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS,** the Council adopted Ordinance 2020-9 on March 12, 2020 making "Permanent" appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures for January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, the annual appropriations ordinance needs to be amended to include the transfer of funds according to Resolution 2020-18; and the expenditures related to Riverside TIF Fund; and,

WHEREAS, immediate action is required to make appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of South Lebanon, State of Ohio, for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, and such action is necessary in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** By the Council of the Village of South Lebanon, Ohio at least two-thirds of the current members elected thereto, concurring that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of South Lebanon during the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.
